Letter and Number of the Week

Beginning each September, the teachers also start the school preparatory program with Letter and Number of the Week activities. During these studies, children are introduced to the alphabet and numbers through songs, art, rhymes, and books. They practice writing the letter (in both uppercase and lowercase) and number of the week, they locate items in the class that begin with the letter of the week and add them to the alphabet tree, they recite the letter of the week poem daily, and they bring in show-n-tell items that begin with the letter of the week to hone their group speaking skills.
